WHEREAS, promoting and protecting the health, safety, and wellbeing of individuals, families, and our communities is a major goal of Lane County, and


WHEREAS, May is recognized as National Mental Health Month; and

WHEREAS, the observance of National Mental Health Month affords an opportunity to recognize contributions of local community organizations towards promoting mental health issues; and


