RESOLUTION AND ORDER: IN THE MATTER OF authorizing Youth Services developing and submitting a grant application to the United States Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention for Building Protective Factors to Combat Juvenile Delinquency Grants in the Amount of \$500,000 to 3,000,000 and Acceptance of the Grant is Awarded

WHEREAS, Lane County Department of Youth Services provides evidence based interventions and services to high-risk, delinquent youth in Lane County, Oregon; and


WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention is soliciting grant proposals for building protective factors to combat juvenile delinquency in the amount of \$500,000 to 3,000,000 for 3 years; and

WHEREAS, Youth Services is the juvenile justice provider for Lane County and has been implementing the principles of effective practice throughout their service continuum but will need additional resources to ensure that all programming meets the needs of the juvenile offenders and operates at the highest level of efficiency and achieves the maximum expected outcomes; and

RESOLVED and ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners authorize Youth Services to develop and submit an application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention for Building Protective Factors to Combat Juvenile Delinquency Grants and delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign the application and acceptance of the grant if awarded, and

FURTHER ORDERED that the county administrator be delegated authority to execute grant documents and sign a subsequent contract.
