IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING FAYE STEWART  
TO THE LANE COUNTY SUPERVISORY  
AUTHORITY TEAM (SAT)

**WHEREAS**, on November 26, 2002, the Lane County Board of Commissioners adopted a Supervisory Authority Team (SAT) model for the adult corrections system; and

**WHEREAS**, members of the SAT consisted of the Sheriff's Office Corrections Division Commander, the Parole and Probation Manager, and the Presiding Judge of the Circuit Court or his/her designated judge; and


**WHEREAS**, on March 12, 2008, the Lane County Board of Commissioners transferred Lane County Parole and Probation services from the Department of Health and Human Services to the Department of Public Safety on a trial basis until the end of the present term of office of Sheriff Burger, at which point the Lane County Parole and Probation Services function automatically reverts to the authority of the Board of County Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, at that time, the Lane County Board of Commissioners restructured the composition of the SAT to be comprised of the Sheriff, the Presiding Judge and a County Commissioner; and

**WHEREAS**, this matter having been fully considered by the Lane County Board of Commissioners; now therefore

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, that Commissioner Faye Stewart be appointed to serve on the Lane County Supervisory Authority Team.


