
WHEREAS, at a duly publicized time and place on August 20, 2010, Barry Pitzer, Energy Services Supervisor of the Housing and Community Services Agency of Lane County, opened bids on the following project:

Manufacture and delivery of vinyl replacement windows for the Weatherization of Homes Project 10-M-0066, in accordance with project specifications prepared by the Agency.

WHEREAS, the apparent low responsible bid for the work was \$816.31 (weighted price) submitted by Empire Pacific Windows; and the Executive Director having so recommended, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED, that Empire Pacific Windows be awarded the vinyl replacement window contract for the Weatherization of Homes Project, 10-M-0066, for a total cost not to exceed \$350,000, and that an agreement be executed by the Executive Director in accordance with the bid documents. The Contractor shall present a valid performance and payment bond in the full amount and shall satisfactorily complete all work within the specified contract time.
