WHEREAS, approximately 3% of the population is born with a developmental disability, including mental retardation, autism and cerebral palsy; and

WHEREAS, vocational and job training opportunities for adults with developmental disabilities are necessary to ensure the individual's ability to contribute to the community; and

WHEREAS, the month of October 1998 has been designated as National Disability Employment Awareness Month by the President's Committee on Employment of People with Disabilities; and

WHEREAS, Pearl Buck Center Incorporated is celebrating the provision of education and vocational services to individuals with developmental disabilities for 45 years; and

WHEREAS, the services provided by Pearl Buck Center Incorporated have assisted individuals with developmental disabilities in Lane County to become tax payers within the community in which they live; and

WHEREAS, Pearl Buck Center Incorporated requests public and private support and assistance as it continues to work toward a society where people are recognized for their abilities, not their disabilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lane County Commissioners serving the citizens of Lane County, Oregon, that Thursday, October 29, 1998 is hereby proclaimed PEARL BUCK CENTER DAY, and the Commissioners commend this observance to all citizens of Lane County, Oregon.
