WHEREAS, Lane County's New Opportunities grant is designed to assist Lane County in the development and improvement of community infrastructure for the treatment of serious mental and emotional problems in children and adolescents; and

WHEREAS, wraparound planning is an integral part of the Federal New Opportunities grant received by Lane County; and

WHEREAS, Bethel School District has developed a pilot program to provide wraparound planning in a school setting; and

WHEREAS, Lane County contracted with Bethel School District to provide funding for the pilot program; and

WHEREAS, this amendment will allow Bethel School District to continue wraparound service planning and increase wraparound planning services to students; now therefore it is hereby

ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign a contract amendment with Bethel School District in the amount of \$58,375 for the period October 1, 1998 to August 31, 1999.
