IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING A SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION CONTINUATION GRANT FOR \$476,490 AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE GRANT DOCUMENTS, AGREEMENTS, AND CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Coordinating Council, created under ORS 423.560, is developing a comprehensive plan for the community safety and justice system, and

WHEREAS, one of the key components of this system is criminal diversion programs, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office, in partnership with other community agencies, has a diversion program in place, and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has awarded a continuation grant from funds available under the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) to Lane County to enhance and evaluate its criminal justice diversion program for individuals with mental illness and substance abuse addictions,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. the Board of County Commissioners accept the continuation grant awarded by SAMHSA
2. the County Administrator execute grant documents as appropriate with SAMHSA
3. the County Administrator execute the following agreements and contracts —
