WHEREAS, crisis respite services are a part of LaneCare's plan for managed mental health care; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that developmentally disabled clients may need specialized placement for these services; and

WHEREAS, a letter of intent process was conducted for crisis services for developmentally disabled mentally ill clients and The Sherman Center was the only respondent and is qualified to provide these services; now therefore it is

RESOLVED and ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners award a contract to The Sherman Center to provide crisis services to developmentally disabled mentally ill clients; and further

ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the county administrator to sign a contract with The Sherman Center to serve on the LaneCare provider panel for the period December 1, 1998 through September 30, 1999.
