(ODOT) AND WEYERHAEUSER
(COMPANY FOR THE LONDON ROAD
(SLIDE PROJECT

WHEREAS, on July 8, 1998, the Board of Commissioners requested an evaluation of the geotechnical aspects of permanently moving London Road to the current detour alignment without performing stabilization work towards the slide itself; and

WHEREAS, the geotechnical evaluation by L.R. Squier and Associates dated July 24, 1998, concluded that option posed a potentially unacceptable risk to the County. In their opinion, movements in the slope and presently heaved portion of the road will continue without stabilization measures; and

WHEREAS, given the analysis by Squier & Associates, a tentative agreement has been reached with Weyerhaeuser regarding division of responsibility for slide stabilization and road repair. In the agreement, Weyerhaeuser will install trench drains on the upper portion of the slide. Lane County will be responsible for road repairs on London Road and stabilization of the lower slide—chiefly construction of a rock toe buttress along London Road. Weyerhaeuser will convey any necessary right-of-way to the County for that portion of the project; and

WHEREAS, through a separate agreement with ODOT, Federal Highway Administration Emergency Relief (ER) funding will be pursued to pay for 90% of the rock toe buttress construction along London Road. This work will occur in 1999. The County match for the ER project is estimated at \$50,000 to \$100,000; NOW
THEREFORE BE IT

ORDERED, that an agreement with Weyerhaeuser Company is authorized regarding stabilization and road repair responsibilities and a local agency agreement with ODOT is authorized for securing ER funding in the estimated amount of \$700,000 with a corresponding County match of \$50,000 to \$100,000 for the London Road slide project; **IT IS FURTHER**

ORDERED, that the County Administrator is authorized to execute both agreements.
