 ) CONTROL COMMISSION (OLCC) FOR  
 ) PROVIDING FUEL, MAINTENANCE AND  
 ) REPAIR OF OLCC VEHICLES FOR THREE  
 ) (3) YEARS FROM DATE OF EXECUTION

**WHEREAS**, ORS 190.010 and the Lane County Home Rule Charter provide that units of local government may enter into agreements for the performance of any and all functions and activities that a party to the agreements, its officers or agents have authority to perform; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane County and various public agencies have established a policy of mutual cooperation on projects of mutual benefit and of benefit to the public at large; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Oregon, Liquor Control Commission has vehicles but no facilities or personnel for repair and maintenance of said vehicles, and Lane County has such facilities and personnel; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Oregon has occasional need for fuel which Lane County has available, therefore it is hereby

**ORDERED** that Lane County enter into a three (3) year agreement with the State of Oregon, Liquor Control Commission to provide fuel, maintenance, and repair of OLCC vehicles, and it is further

**ORDERED** that the County Administrator be delegated the authority to execute the agreement on behalf of the County.
