WHEREAS, the Lane County Department of Health and Human Services has received funding for New Opportunities from the U.S Department of Health and Human Services; and

WHEREAS, Family Support Workers are a primary component of the New Opportunities program; and

WHEREAS, the majority of Family Support Workers have historically been out stationed in private non-profits; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the New Opportunities grant will be better met by bringing 4.0 FTE of Mental Health Associate positions into Lane County; and

WHEREAS, funds for these positions will come from lapse funds from unfilled positions within the New Opportunities program; now therefore it is hereby

RESOLVED and ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners create 4.0 FTE Mental Health Associate positions in the Lane County Department of Health and Human Services
