WHEREAS, the United States Marshals Service has a need for additional beds in Lane County because of the federal courthouse in Lane County, and

WHEREAS, the United States Marshals Service administers a Cooperative Agreement Program to provide funds to local jurisdictions for new construction, and

WHEREAS, Lane County made application to the United States Marshals Service for Cooperative Agreement Program funds to augment construction of the new jail addition, and

WHEREAS, Lane County agreed to rent 50 beds to the United States Marshals Service upon completion of the construction, and

WHEREAS, the United States Marshals Service approved Lane County's Cooperative Agreement Program application, and

WHEREAS, Lane County has an existing Intergovernmental Service Agreement with the United States Marshals Service to provide 20 beds for federal prisoners, and

WHEREAS, the approval of the Cooperative Agreement Program application requires an amendment of the existing Intergovernmental Service Agreement, providing 50 beds to the United States Marshals Service upon completion of the construction, and

WHEREAS, Lane County received from the United States Marshals Service the amended Intergovernmental Service Agreement on April 8, 1998 with the requirement that it be returned to the United States Marshals Service headquarters no later than April 23, 1998, and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners was not scheduled to meet prior to April 22, 1998 leaving insufficient time to delegate authority to execute the amended Intergovernmental Service Agreement and return it to the United States Marshals Service headquarters prior to April 23, 1998, and

WHEREAS, the County Administrator and Sheriff have executed the amended Intergovernmental Service Agreement and returned it to the United States Marshals Service headquarters in order to meet the April 23, 1998 deadline, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners needs to ratify execution of the amended Intergovernmental Service Agreement, it is hereby

Ordered that the Board of County Commissioners ratify the execution of the amended Intergovernmental Service Agreement with the United States Marshals Service by the County Administrator and the Sheriff.


