ORDER NO. 98-) IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING AND RATIFYING A
98-5-13-9 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE LANE
COUNTY PEACE OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION, INC.

WHEREAS, a tentative agreement has been reached between Lane County and the Lane County Peace Officers' Association, Inc.;

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners to be consistent in granting general wage increases to all County employees;

WHEREAS, the funds to pay for these costs are already budgeted in the Fiscal Year 98-99 proposed budget;

WHEREAS, Lane Manual 2.230 and 2.235 require Board approval for amending the compensation plan; and

IT IS NOW HEREBY ORDERED, that the compensation plan for all classifications of the Lane County Peace Officers' Association and the corresponding salaries of incumbent employees within these classification be adjusted as follows:

Effective July 1, 1998, the salary schedule of the current agreement shall be increased by 1.7%.

Effective January 1, 1999, the salary schedule of the current agreement shall be increased by 2.0%


