ORDER/IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING A BID  
AND AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE OF  
INSULATED REPLACEMENT WINDOWS,  
WEATHERIZATION OF HOMES PROJECT  
98-M-0052.

WHEREAS, at a duly publicized time and place on April 21,  
1998, Craig Satein, Weatherization Supervisor of the Housing  
Authority and Community Services Agency of Lane County, opened bids  
on the following project:

Manufacture and delivery of insulated  
replacement windows for the Weatherization of  
Homes Project, in accordance with project  
specifications prepared by the Agency.

WHEREAS, the apparent low responsible bid for the work was  
\$366.36 (weighted price) submitted by Insulate Industries; and the  
Executive Director having so recommended, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED, that Insulate Industries be awarded the insulated  
replacement window contract for the Weatherization of Homes  
Project, 98-M-0052, for a total cost not to exceed \$250,000, and  
that the agreement be executed by the Executive Director in  
accordance with the bid documents. The Contractor shall present a  
valid performance and payment bond in the full amount of \$250,000,  
and shall satisfactorily complete all work within the specified  
contract time.


