WHEREAS, the City of Westfir has proposed the week of July 19 through July 25, 1998 as "Project Pride Week" to promote improvement of the looks of the community, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the project is to encourage Westfir residents to improve the looks of the community by disposing of unsightly refuse and to help their friends and neighbors who may not be able to do yard work or other things that would beautify the community, and

WHEREAS, Lane County has a policy (Lane Manual 60.875(4)) of permitting waiver of dumping fees for city or community group clean-up programs, within certain limitations,

WHEREAS, Lane County encourages these types of community improvement efforts

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Lane County recognizes the week of July 19th, 1998 as Project Pride week in the City of Westfir, and it is further

ORDERED that within the delegations described in the Lane Manual, the Director of Public Works shall appropriately consider the application of the waiver of dumping fees for this project.
