ORDER 96-3-6-16) IN THE MATTER OF REQUESTING FUNDING FROM THE

) EMERGENCY WATERSHED PROTECTION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is committed to assisting communities and citizens with rebuilding after the flood of 1996 wherever possible and reasonable, and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Conservation Service, through the Emergency Watershed Protection Program, provides an opportunity to partner with local governments in providing technical and financial assistance to communities for restoring watersheds and properties ravaged by natural disasters, and

WHEREAS, we understand that if an emergency watershed protection project is identified, our responsibilities as a project sponsor will include acquiring land rights and permits needed to construct, and if required, to operate and maintain the proposed measures. We assure prior to individual project submittal that there will be a 25 percent local match (in-kind and/or cash) provided for the construction work.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY:

ORDERED THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REQUEST FEDERAL ASSISTANCE UNDER PROVISIONS OF SECTION 403, AGRICULTURAL CREDIT ACT OF 1978, TO RESTORE DAMAGED CHANNEL AND STREAM FACILITIES CAUSED BY THE FEBRUARY 1996 FLOODING.

FURTHER ORDERED THAT THE PROJECT LIST WILL BE RETURNED TO THE BOARD FOR APPROVAL.
