In the Matter of Approving the Expenditure of the Lane County Fund 28 Affordable Housing Program (Materials & Services Category) in the Amount of \$85,000 to Assist in the Acquisition of Village Oaks Apartments.

WHEREAS, HACSA's mission is to address the community issues of homelessness and increasing the supply of permanent, affordable housing for lower income households;

WHEREAS, HACSA is attempting to acquire the apartment complex named Village Oaks Apartments in order to maintain an important community resource of low-income, affordable housing;

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Housing Policy Board has requested that HACSA pursue the acquisition of Village Oaks;

WHEREAS, HACSA requires financial assistance in order to implement this acquisition;

WHEREAS, Lane County wishes to assist HACSA in carrying out this acquisition;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that

THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR IS AUTHORIZED TO EFFECTUATE THE TRANSFER OF \$85,000 FROM THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAM (MATERIALS & SERVICES CATEGORY) IN THE FUND 28 SPECIAL REVENUE/SERVICES FUND TO THE LANE COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY AND COMMUNITY SERVICES AGENCY TO ASSIST IN THE ACQUISITION OF THE VILLAGE OAKS APARTMENTS.
