

WHEREAS Lane County has contracted with Brian Pocock for workers' compensation legal services for fiscal years 95-96, 96-97, and 97-98, not to exceed \$75,000 for the three year period, and

WHEREAS, after analysis of Lane County's increasing need for legal services in workers' compensation due to the increased number of active claims and continuous legislative changes, the current contract amount has proven inadequate to meet the County's needs, and in accordance with Lane Manual Chapter 21.205, 4 (c) indicating good cause to waive selection procedures,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the County Administrator is delegated the authority to execute an amended personal services contract with Brian L. Pocock for Workers' Compensation legal services to increase the total not-to-exceed cost by \$169,474 from \$75,000 to \$244,474 which includes \$56,974 for billings from 1993, 1994 and 1995 plus not-to-exceed \$56,250 for 1996/97 and not-to-exceed \$56,250 for 1997/98; require billing within 60 days of services provided; and re-write the scope of work.
