) IN THE MATTER OF APPOINTING A
) MEMBER TO THE REDISTRICTING
) TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, the Lane County Charter, Chapter 11, Section 11(3)(d) and (e), addresses the issue of adjusting commissioner district boundaries: (d) In accordance with Federal, State, or County census figures, the boundaries of the five districts shall be drawn by the Board of Commissioners so as not to deny any person equal protection of the law; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners shall, not less than every 10 years, initiate review of the population densities of each district and modify boundaries when necessary. No boundary creation, position designation or boundary change shall disqualify a commissioner from completing the term of office to which that commissioner was elected or appointed; and


WHEREAS, the Board appointed members to a Redistricting Task Force on March 14, 2001 in Board Order 01-3-14-1; and


WHEREAS, Denise Pratt, who is Commissioner Morrison's appointee, is unable to serve during the next few weeks, during which time the Task Force is scheduled to complete its work; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Morrison desires to have a substitute appointed, and the Board concurs that it is best to have a full complement of Task Force members representing the Board Members.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ellie Dumdi is hereby appointed to the Redistricting Task Force to complete the term of Denise Pratt.
