) HIGHWAY 101 AS AN "ALL AMERICAN
) ROAD" UNDER THE NATIONAL SCENIC
BYWAY PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, in 1998, Highway 101 was one of the first highways in the nation to be designated a National Scenic Byway, which has netted \$3.72 million to build projects along Highway 101 as well as provided economic support to the coastal communities; and

WHEREAS, the National Scenic Byways program is a voluntary grant program administered by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA); and

WHEREAS, in 1991 Oregon established the "Scenic Byways Program" as part of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA), and

WHEREAS, residents and local government officials favor the nomination of Highway 101 for National Scenic Byway designation as the area covered by the National Scenic Byway designation protects the "intrinsic qualities" of the Highway 101 corridor and places no additional demands on coastal communities.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Lane County Board of Commissioners hereby supports designating Highway 101 as an "All American Road."
