
WHEREAS, the OCCF is authorized to grant funds to local Commissions on Children and Families to implement research based, best or promising practices that are outcome driven and aligned with local comprehensive planning, and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Commission on Children and Families submitted and received approval for Phase One of the Early Childhood Plan and Coordinated Comprehensive Plan and for the LCCCF Report on allocations, and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Legislature has directed local Healthy Start programs to claim eligible reimbursement and has included projected reimbursement in total funding allocations for local programs, and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the County Administrative Officer to execute the Oregon Commission on Children and Families grant agreement in the amount of \$5,927,681 and the Intergovernmental Agreement for Title XIX Medicaid Reimbursement in the amount of \$237,500.
