Chapter 3

License for Retail Sale of Firearms

3.500 Licensing Authority. Pursuant to the authority of ORS 166.430 as interpreted by Opinions of the Attorney General 1966, p. 31, the Board hereby declares itself the licensing authority to grant licenses for the retail sale of firearms in the unincorporated areas of Lane County.

3.505 Administrative Processing Fee. A fee for each annual application shall be charged at the time the application is filed with the Board in an amount to be established by separate order of the Board.

3.510 Planning and Public Safety Approvals. No license shall be granted under the authority of ORS 166.430 until the location of the proposed retail establishment has been certified to be in conformity with land use regulations by the Planning Department or its designee and until the Sheriff has certified that he has no information which would indicate that the applicant is not of good moral character.
