ORDINANCE NO. 4-74

AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF LANE CODE

The Board of County Commissioners of Lane County ordains as follows:

Chapter 5 of Lane Code is hereby amended by removing and substituting the following page:

The purpose of this substitution is to amend the dog license section to include as a condition that no dog license will be issued until a certificate of vaccination for rabies issued by a licensed veterinarian valid through the applied for license year is presented to the Lane County Department of Public Safety, Dog Control and License Division.

This ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1974.

through the Division, and within the four (4) day period, a hearing before the County Infractions Section to determine whether the dog is a vicious dog or did kill or injure livestock. When a hearing has been formally requested, the dog shall not be destroyed until at least two (2) working days after the determination of the County Infractions Section. The determination of the County Infractions Section shall be in writing and shall include the appropriate express findings.

5.210 Redemption and Sale.

(1) Redemption of an impounded dog by the owner shall be made by exhibiting satisfactory proof of ownership and by paying the following charges:

- (a) Impoundment charge of ten (10) dollars.
- (b) The additional charge of two (2) dollars for each day or fraction thereof that the dog was impounded.
- (c) The additional charge of any necessary license fee.

(2) Impounded dogs may be sold for any reasonable price.

(3) Where the dogs are impounded in an animal shelter maintained by a private organization under contract with the county, the impoundment fee shall be remitted to the county and the additional charge imposed by subsection (1)(b) and the sales price of dogs sold shall be retained by the private organization.

(4) At the time of purchase, a new owner shall obtain any necessary license.

(5) No impoundment charge shall be made for a dog released after a hearing under subsection 5.205(3).

5.215 Dog License. Every owner of a dog in the county which has a set of permanent canine teeth or which has attained the age of four (4) months, whichever event may occur first, shall procure not later than January 2 of every year a license for each such dog. This requirement is subject to the following qualifications:

(a) The annual deadline shall be the first working day after January 2 if January 2 falls on a holiday or a weekend.

(b) If the dog first becomes subject to the licensing requirements after January 2, the license shall be obtained within thirty (30) days of the date the dog becomes eligible.

(c) If a dog required to be licensed has just been first acquired by the owner, the owner shall have thirty (30) days from the date of acquiring the dog to obtain the required license. A similar period shall be granted to owners bringing their dogs into the county from another country or state.

(d) No license shall be issued until a certificate of vaccination for rabies issued by a licensed veterinarian valid through the applied for license year is presented to the Lane County Department of Public Safety, Dog Control and License Division.
