25. ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

a. CONTINUED PUBLIC HEARING/Ordinance No. 3-79 Amending Chapter 10 of  
Lane Code (Zoning) to Establish Maximum Limitations for Rural Home  
Occupations

Lee Miller, Environmental Management, said that an amendment was being  
suggested to 10.342-10(7) as follows:

The operation or use of equipment or processes likely to produce  
producing or cause causing the emission of gases, dust, odors, noise  
or light in a manner likely to cause offense or irritation to  
neighboring residences violation of federal, state or county laws or  
regulations controlling such emission shall not be permitted.

Miller noted that the new reading would require another hearing.  
Freeman opened the public hearing.
