WHEREAS, on July 19, 1979 the City of Cottage Grove executed an intergovernmental agreement with Lane County agreeing to accept jurisdiction for Mosby Creek Road from Airport Road to Currin Connector in exchange for Lane County relocating the City water transmission line from Row River Road Stations L-53+00 to L200+00, and

WHEREAS, said relocation has been accomplished, and

WHEREAS, Lane County has further agreed in said intergovernmental agreement to pay all appropriate costs up to \$225,000 and

WHEREAS, Lane County Board of County Commissioners has held all required public hearings and adopted Order 79-11-28-20 on November 28, 1979 as prescribed under ORS 373, and

WHEREAS, Lane County Local Government Boundary Commission annexed said roadway to the City of Cottage Grove on October 2, 1980.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Cottage Grove accepts Lane County's offer and hereby establishes legal jurisdiction for the roadway known as Mosby Creek Road from Airport Road to Currin Connector.

Passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor this 13th day of October, 1980.
