The Board reconvened at 1:30 p.m. Vice-Chairman Harold Rutherford presided with Commissioners Vance Freeman and Archie Weinstein present. Commissioners Gerald Rust and Otto t'Hooft were absent, on vacation.

22. COMMISSIONERS' ANNOUNCEMENTS AND BUSINESS

Morgan told the Board that since there had been much publicity recently regarding the financial position of the State of Oregon he felt it necessary to make a statement at this time. He said a special session of the legislation was called to be held on August 4 and further information would be available after that meeting. Morgan reminded the Board that approximately \$10,000,000 was allocated to the County from the state in the adopted 80-81 budget and the County could expect a severe impact if drastic cuts are made. He said presently everything was speculative only but a two percent reduction had already occurred in the Mental Health program. Morgan stressed that this was advisory information and he would keep the Board further advised with any further information he would receive.

Rutherford asked if the Board could take a matter to be placed under Emergency Business out of order regarding the approval of a zone variance and adopting Findings of Fact for David Kommer. The Board so agreed.
