WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received from Lane County Planning Commission a report dated December 2, 1980, and from the West Lane Planning Commission a report dated December 3, 1980, of record herein, both recommending adoption of the "Lane County Parks and Open Space Master Plan;" and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received and considered the "Lane County Parks and Open Space Master Plan," public testimony and correspondence relating thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has performed its public hearing and other duties in accordance with applicable law, now therefore

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That the "Lane County Parks and Open Space Master Plan, dated April 1980 (copy attached hereto and indicated as Appendix "A"), as modified by changes in the Staff Report to the Board of County Commissioners, dated January 1981 (copy attached hereto and indicated as Appendix "B"), is ADOPTED, with the following changes: delete Recommendation 3, page 57; Delete Policy #6 which reads, "The County shall continue to encourage the implementation of a mass transit system throughout the County, where feasible. This system should be designed to transport citizens of various population centers to particular recreation areas and facilities."; Change Policy #8 to read as follows: "The County shall encourage the implementation of the Countywide bike trail system;" Delete Policy #15, "The County encourages the development of recreational facilities on public school lands and shall cooperate in the planning and developing of these school facilities with the appropriate agency involved in implementation; Add language as underlined to Policy #24, the County shall when feasible on every other year conduct a usage survey of the park lands. Data obtained from this survey will be incorporated in this element of the Comprehensive Plan. The results of this survey will be made available for public comment.



safety, shall take effect immediately upon the adoption of an Order adopting Findings of Fact concerning this action.


