5.255(1)

5.249 Dead Dogs - Removal of Carcasses. No person shall knowingly permit a dog carcass owned by said person to remain on public property, or to be exposed on private property, for more than 24 hours.

5.255 Killing and Chasing Livestock, Fowl, Poultry and Domestic Furbearing Animals.

(1) Any dog which chases, kills, wounds or injures livestock not belonging to its owner while off the premises owned or under the control of its owner may be killed immediately by any person or impounded at any time by the Dog Control Authority.

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
