15.225 Lane Code 15.230

15.225 Unopened Established County Rights-of-Way. Rights-of-way legally established for County road purposes over which roads have not been constructed shall not be opened for purposes of private access or land development at public expense. Construction of roads in these circumstances shall be as specified by facility permit and through the land development process, if applicable, at the expense of the applicant.

[15.230 Lengths of Vehicles, Loads and Combinations of Vehicles Allowable Upon Lane County Roads Without Need of Special Transportation Permits. Certain types and combinations of vehicles may be operated without special length permits upon Lane County roads, except those roads or segments of roads assigned limitations in accordance with ORS 487.905, when the overall length of the vehicles, combination of vehicles or loads do not exceed that as established in Table 1, below. In combinations featuring more than one trailer or semi-trailer, the shortest trailer shall be positioned to the rear of the combination.

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


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
