UNLAWFUL PUBLIC ACCOMMODATIONS PRACTICE

6.800 Unlawful Public Accommodations Practice. It shall be an unlawful public accommodations practice for a person being the owner, lessee, proprietor, manager, superintendent, agent or employee of a place of public accommodation.

(1) To refuse or deny an individual the accommodations or use of the facilities of the place of public accommodation because of the race, color, religion, sex, national origin, physical handicap or marital status of that individual; or

(2) To circulate, issue, display, post or mail a communication, notice or advertisement which states that the accommodations or use of the facilities of the place of public accommodation shall be refused or denied to an individual on account of the race, color, religion, sex, national origin, physical handicap or marital status of that individual.

(3) For purposes of this section of the Lane Code, public accommodation means a place of business, accommodation, refreshment, entertainment, recreation and public conveyance operated on land or water whose merchandise, service, accommodation, advantages facilities or privileges are extended, offered, sold or otherwise made available to the general public. Public accommodations include, but are not limited to, restaurants, taverns, motels, hotels, commercial stores and vehicles used in the conveyance of the general public.

PENALTIES

6.995 Penalties.

(1) Violation of LC 6.025 or 6.800 is punishable upon conviction by fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment in the County jail for not more than 30 days, or by both.

(2) Violation of LC 6.200, 6.710 or 6.715 is punishable upon conviction by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment in the County jail for not more than one year, or by both.

(3) Violation of LC 6.515, 6.540, 6.555, 6.580 or 6.590 is punishable upon conviction by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment in the County jail for not more than six months, or by both.
