5.400 Nonmotorized Traffic Prohibitions.

(1) Except for those persons engaged in obtaining emergency services for a disabled motor vehicle, those persons performing duties in connection with repair and maintenance of the road or other lawful governmental function, or those persons that have received a permit from the Director, Lane County Department of Public Works no person shall walk or go upon the following described area in nonmotorized vehicles:

Any part of the right-of-way which is enclosed by fences or which is 80 feet from the centerline of that portion of Delta Highway commencing at the point at which Delta Highway intersects County Road No. 515, commonly known as Country Club Road, then continuing northerly to the point at which Delta Highway passes over Beltline Road.

(2) The Director, Lane County Department of Public Works, may issue permits to those persons that make application for the purpose of operating a bicycle or walking in the area described in LC 5.400(1) to persons 16 years of age or older.

(3) The application and permit shall be in a form as prescribed by the Director, Lane County Department of Public Works, and any permit issued shall be carried at all times by the permittee while utilizing the areas described in LC 5.400(1). In approving a permit, the Director herein may include such reasonable conditions such as prohibited hours as in said Director's sole discretion is determined reasonably necessary for the public safety.

(4) In addition to persons authorized under LC 5.990, any peace officer having the authority to sign traffic citations for violation of traffic statutes on the freeways included in the area described in LC 5.400(1) shall have the authority to sign County Infraction Complaints.

(5) Any person who violates this section commits a Class C Infraction.

P A R K S

5.500 Definitions. For the purposes of LC 5.500 through and including 5.550, the following words and phrases shall mean: County Park. Any real property or rights in property heretofore or hereafter acquired by Lane County and designated by Order of the Board pursuant to ORS 275.320 as County Forest, Public Park, or Recreational Area.

5.502 Fires.

(1) No person shall build, light or maintain any fire or dispose of lighted charcoal or other burning material within a County Park except in a stove, pit or fireplace provided for such purpose; excepting however, that portable cooking devices may be used in established campground and picnic areas if in safe operating conditions and used in a safe manner and so as not to cause damage to park grounds or facilities.

(2) No person shall leave a fire unattended and must completely extinguish the fire prior to departure.

(3) Violation constitutes a Class A Infraction.

5.505 Weapons.

(1) No person shall discharge within a County Park any weapon capable of harming persons, wild life or property.

(2) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.505(1) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(3) Violation constitutes a Class A Infraction.

5.510 Hunting and Fishing.

(1) No person shall hunt, pursue, trap, molest, injure or kill any game or non-game wildlife within a County Park.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of LC 5.510(1), fishing is permitted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the State Department of Fish and Wildlife.

(3) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.510(1) and not permitted by LC 5.510(2) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(4) Violation constitutes a Class A Infraction.

5.512 Destruction of Property.

(1) No person shall deface, damage, destroy or remove any County Park structure, sign, facility, plant, tree, wood, soil, gravel, sand or other substance, except duly authorized County employees or agents in the performance of their duties.

(2) Activities otherwise prohibited by LM 5.512(1) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(3) Violation constitutes a Class A Infraction.

5.515 Sales.

(1) No person shall operate a concession or engage in the business of advertising, soliciting or selling any goods or services, within a County Park.

(2) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.515(1) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent pursuant to LM 18.140.

(3) Violation constitutes a Class C Infraction.

5.525 Vehicle Operation and Parking. No person shall:

(1) Operate any vehicle, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, motorbikes, trail bikes, mountain bikes and off-road vehicles within a County Park on other than established vehicular roads, parking areas or boat ramps or in areas specifically designated and posted for such use. Violation of this subsection constitutes a Class C Infraction.

(2) Park or leave unattended any vehicle or trailer within a County Park in other than those areas designated for such parking. Violation of this subsection constitutes a Class C Infraction.

(3) Operate a vehicle at a speed greater than 15 miles per hour unless designated and posted otherwise. Violation of this subsection constitutes a Class B Infraction.

(4) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.525(1) and (2) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

5.527 Household Garbage.

(1) No person shall dispose or dump any household or commercial garbage, trash, rubbish, debris, dead animals or litter of any kind within a County Park.

(2) Violation constitutes a Class A Infraction.

5.530 Dogs and Other Pets.

(1) No person shall bring any dog or other pet into Baker Bay, Camp Lane, Dexter, Harbor Vista, Jasper, Lowell, Orchard Point, Richardson, Triangle Lake, or Winberry parks or area posted "dogs on leash only," unless such pet is on a leash, not to exceed six feet in length.

(2) Violation constitutes a Class C Infraction.

5.535 Horses and Riding Animals.

(1) No person shall ride, drive, lead or keep a horse or other riding animal within a County Park.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of LC 5.535(1), horses or other riding animals are permitted on roadways and designated and posted equestrian trails.

(3) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.535(1) and not permitted by LC 5.535(2) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(4) Violation constitutes a Class C Infraction.

5.537 Creating a Disturbance.

(1) No person shall operate a radio, tape deck or other sound producing device in such a manner that plainly audible sound, as defined in LC 6.505, is present at a distance of fifty feet or more, from the source of the sound.

(2) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.537(1) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(3) Violation constitutes a Class C Infraction.

5.543 Swimming.

(1) No person shall enter, wade, swim or float, in any area within a County Park which has been posted "No Swimming" by the Board or its duly authorized agent, except duly authorized County employees or agents in the performance of their duties.

(2) No person shall sunbathe on a boating courtesy dock.

(3) Violation constitutes a Class B Infraction.

(1) No person shall enter any County Park or portion thereof which has been closed by the Board or its duly authorized agent nor shall any person operate a vehicle within any County Park or portion thereof which has been closed to vehicles by the Board or its duly authorized agent, except duly authorized County employees or agents in the performance of their duties.

(2) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.544(1) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(3) Violation constitutes a Class A/B Infraction.

5.545 Camping.

(1) No person shall camp or park overnight in any area within a County park.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of LC 5.545(1), camping is permitted in areas specifically designated as public campgrounds.

(3) No person shall camp in a designated public campground in a County Park for a period longer than 14 days in any 30 consecutive day period.

(4) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.545(1) and not permitted by LC 5.545(2) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(5) Violation constitutes a Class B Infraction.

5.547 After Hours.

(1) No person shall enter or remain in any County Park between the daily closing time and the daily opening time, except duly authorized County employees or agents in the performance of their duties.

(2) Notwithstanding the provision of LC 5.547(1) moorage holders and/or their guests may remain on their boats after hours.

(3) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.547(1) and not permitted by LC 5.547(2) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(4) Violation constitutes a Class A/B Infraction.

5.550 Fees. The Board may establish fees for the use of County Parks and facilities. Such fees shall be established by separate Order of the Board.

Littering5.800 Littering and Penalty.

(1) Any person who throws or places, or who directs or permits another person to throw or place, other than in receptacles provided therefor, upon the private land or waters of another person without the permission of the owner, or upon public lands or waters, or upon any public place, any rubbish, trash, garbage, debris or other refuse, commits the infraction of littering.

(2) A person who violates this section commits a Class A Infraction.

(3) Evidence of a name found on an item in a deposit of illegally dumped rubbish, which would ordinarily denote ownership of the item, such as the name of an addressee on an envelope, shall constitute prima facie evidence that the person whose name appears on the item has violated LC 5.800.

5.990 Infractions, Violations. Violation of any provision of LC Chapters 9, 10 or 11 constitutes a Class A Infraction, except for a violation of LC 9.745, which shall constitute a Class B Infraction. A Summons and Complaint alleging violation of LC 5.400, 5.500 through 5.547, 5.700 through 5.745 and 5.800 may be signed, issued and served by any officer, employee or designated agent of the County.

County Park [or Park]. [A park owned by Lane County or a park outside the Eugene-Springfield city limits owned by the Willamalane Park and Recreation District.] Any real property or rights in property heretofore or hereafter acquired by Lane County and designated by Order of the Board pursuant to ORS 275.320 as County Forest, Public Park, or Recreational Area.

(1) Operate [or park] any [automobile, trailer or other]vehicle, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, motorbikes, trail bikes, mountain bikes and off-road vehicles [in any area] within a County Park on other than [in an area provided for such purpose by the Board, or its duly authorized agent.]established vehicular roads, parking areas or boat ramps or in areas specifically designated and posted for such use. Violation of this subsection constitutes a Class C Infraction.

(2) [No person shall drive a vehicle within a County park at a speed greater than 15 miles per hour, nor in any case at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent having due regard to other traffic, and for the width, surface and strength of the area where such vehicle is driven, and to all other hazards and conditions then and there existing.]Park or leave unattended any vehicle or trailer within a County Park in other than those areas designated for such parking. Violation of this subsection constitutes a Class C Infraction.

(3) Operate a vehicle at a speed greater than 15 miles per hour unless designated and posted otherwise. Violation of this subsection constitutes a Class B Infraction.

(4) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.525(1) and (2) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

5.527 Household Garbage.

(1) No person shall dispose or dump any household or commercial garbage, trash, rubbish, debris, dead animals or litter of any kind within a County Park.

(2) Violation constitutes a Class A Infraction.

5.[630]530 Dogs and Other Pets.

(1) No person shall ride, drive, lead or keep a [saddle] horse or other riding animal [in]within a County Park[, except on such roads, trails or areas provided for such purpose by the Board, nor shall any person hitch any horse or other animal to any tree or shrub in such a manner as to cause damage to such tree or shrub].

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of LC 5.535(1), horses or other riding animals are permitted on roadways and designated and posted equestrian trails.

(3) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.535(1) and not permitted by LC 5.535(2) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(4) Violation constitutes a Class C Infraction.

5.537 Creating a Disturbance.

(1) No person shall operate a radio, tape deck or other sound producing device in such a manner that plainly audible sound, as defined in LC 6.505, is present at a distance of fifty feet or more, from the source of the sound.

(2) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.537(1) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(3) Violation constitutes a Class C Infraction.

[5.640 Washing in Lakes or Streams. No person shall wash any clothing or other material or clean any fish in any lake or stream in or immediately adjacent to a County park, except as the Board has approved by an Order describing the specific activity and the reasons for allowing the exception. Violation constitutes a Class C Infraction.]

5.[643]543 Swimming.

(1) No person shall enter, wade, swim or float, in [or on any waterway, stream, river, pool, lake or reservoir, which is in any County land]any area within a County Park which [is or] has been posted "No Swimming" by [Order of]the Board or its [delegee]duly authorized agent, except duly authorized employees or agents in the performance of their duties.

(2) No person shall [enter from County land onto any waterway, stream, river, pool, lake or reservoir without the permission of the owner of such waterway, stream, river, pool, lake or reservoir]sunbathe on a boating courtesy dock.

(1) No person shall enter any County Park or portion thereof which has been closed by the Board or its duly authorized agent nor shall any person operate a vehicle within any County Park or portion thereof which has been closed to vehicles by the Board or its duly authorized agent, except duly authorized County employees or agents in the performance of their duties.

(2) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.544(1) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(3) Violation constitutes a Class A/B Infraction.

5.[645]545 Camping.

(1) No person shall camp or park overnight in any area within a County park[,]. [except in a camp area designated as such by the Board, or its duly authorized agent, nor in any case shall any]

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of LC 5.545(1), camping is permitted in areas specifically designated as public campgrounds.

(3) No person shall camp in a designated public campground in a County Park for a period longer than 14 days in any 30 consecutive day[s] period.

(4) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.545(1) and not permitted by LC 5.545(2) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

[(2)](5) Violation constitutes a Class B Infraction.

5.547 After Hours.

(1) No person shall enter or remain in any County Park between the daily closing time and the daily opening time, except duly authorized County employees or agents in the performance of their duties.

(2) Notwithstanding the provision of LC 5.547(1) moorage holders and/or their guests may remain on their boats after hours.

(3) Activities otherwise prohibited by LC 5.547(1) and not permitted by LC 5.547(2) are permitted with specific written authorization from the Board or its duly authorized agent, pursuant to LM 18.140.

(4) Violation constitutes a Class A/B Infraction.

5.[650]550 Fees. The Board [is authorized to] may establish fees for the use of County Parks and facilities. Such fees shall be established by separate Order of the Board.

Littering5.800 Littering and Penalty.

(1) Any person who throws or places, or who directs or permits another person to throw or place, other than in receptacles provided therefor, upon the private land or waters of another person without the permission of the owner, or upon public lands or waters, or upon any public place, any rubbish, trash, garbage, debris or other refuse, commits the infraction of littering.

(2) A person who violates this section commits a Class A Infraction.

(3) Evidence of a name found on an item in a deposit of illegally dumped rubbish, which would ordinarily denote ownership of the item, such as the name of an addressee on an envelope, shall constitute prima facie evidence that the person whose name appears on the item has violated LC 5.800.

5.990 Infractions, Violations. Violation of any provision of LC Chapters 9, 10 or 11 constitutes a Class A Infraction, except for a violation of LC 9.745, which shall constitute a Class B Infraction. A Summons and Complaint alleging violation of LC 5.400, 5.[600]500 through 5.[645]547, 5.700 through 5.745 and 5.800 may be signed, issued and served by any officer, employee or designated agent of the County.
