ORDINANCE NO. 8-90) IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING ORDINANCE
) NO. 4-90 TO EXTEND THE SUNSET DATE OF
) AUGUST 1, 1990 TO DECEMBER 1, 1990 AND
) DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The Board of County Commissioners of Lane County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 4-90 is amended to extend the sunset date by deleting references to August 1, 1990 and inserting December 1, 1990 in the title and sunset clause. As amended, the sunset clause of Ordinance 4-90 reads as follows:

Unless further amended by the Board, this ordinance shall expire and be of no legal effect on December 1, 1990.

The purpose of this amendment is to assure that Ordinance 4-90 continues in effect through November 30, 1990.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance, being enacted by the Board in the exercise of its police power for the purpose of meeting such emergency and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
