) IN THE MATTER OF SETTING A PUBLIC  
) HEARING ON THE PROPOSED SURRENDER  
) OF FOUR COUNTY ROADS OR PORTIONS  
) THEREOF TO THE CITY OF OAKRIDGE

WHEREAS, the City of Oakridge, by it's Resolution Number 17-90 requested that jurisdiction over the County Roads, or portions thereof, listed on Exhibit "A", attached to and made a part hereof, by this Order be transferred to the City of Oakridge, and

WHEREAS, a certain Intergovernmental Agreement for Urban Transition was signed by Lane County and the City of Oakridge on April 21, 1988, and amended June 29, 1990; which called for the proposed surrender, and

WHEREAS, ORS 373.270 provides for the transfer of jurisdiction over County Roads within a City. The County may transfer jurisdiction over County Roads or parts thereof within a City when it is considered to be necessary, expedient or in the best interest of the County to do so; and the governing body of the City deems it necessary or expedient and in the best interest of the City to acquire jurisdiction over the County Roads or portions thereof to the same extent as it has over public streets and alleys of the City, and

WHEREAS, Lane County and the City of Oakridge deems it necessary and expedient and in the best interest of each governing body to proceed with the transfer of jurisdiction over the County Roads, or portions thereof listed on attached Exhibit "A", now therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED, that a public hearing be set for February 27, 1991, at 1:30 P.M. at Harris Hall, Lane County Courthouse, 125 East 8TH Avenue, Eugene, Oregon to formally consider the surrender of the County Roads, or portions thereof, listed on the attached Exhibit "A"; to the City of Oakridge, and that legal notice of hearing be posted or published, in accordance with ORS 373.270, and further, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Director of the Lane County Department of Public Works prepare and provide a report on the proposed surrender.

FIRST STREET (COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 1067), from the westerly right-of-way line of High Street, being also the West line of the Plat of Hills Addition to Oakridge, Book 8, Page 30, Lane County, Oregon Plat Records, Easterly 2660 feet, more or less, to the westerly right-of-way line of Pine Street, all in Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian.	00.50
PINE STREET (COUNTY ROAD NUMBERS 799, 801 & 1067), from the northerly right-of-way line of First Street, South 324 feet, more or less, to the northerly right-of-way line of Commercial Street, all in Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian.	00.06
SALMON CREEK ROAD (COUNTY ROAD NUMBERS 801 AND 713), from the westerly right-of-way line of Elm Street, Easterly and Northeasterly 520 feet, more or less, to the present easterly City Limits line, all in Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian.	00.10
