ORDER

91-1-30-1H

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF UP TO \$30,000 FROM LANE COUNTY, \$15,000 FROM THE CITY OF EUGENE, AND \$5,000 FROM THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO ASSIST SPONSORS, INC. WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF 10 UNITS OF TRANSITIONAL SINGLE ROOM OCCUPANCY HOUSING.

WHEREAS, HACSA recognizes the need to address the community issues of homelessness and increasing the supply of affordable housing for lower income households in Lane County;

WHEREAS, HACSA has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement to participate in an effort with the City of Springfield, the City of Eugene and Lane County to coordinate local resources in addressing the housing needs of Lane County;


WHEREAS, the Housing Policy Board – the Intergovernmental body for overseeing joint housing development initiatives between jurisdictions in Lane County – has unanimously requested HACSA's assistance in administering intergovernmental contributions towards constructing an additional ten units of transitional housing;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED, that the Lane County Housing Authority and Community Services Agency is authorized to accept funds from Lane County, the City of Eugene, and the City of Springfield and to Assist Sponsors, Inc. with the construction of 10 units of transitional single room occupancy housing. It is further ordered that the Executive Director is authorized to enter into a loan agreement with Sponsors, Inc., the term of which is not to exceed twenty years and the annual interest rate not to exceed ten percent.
