ORDER

91-2-26-1

IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY
ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT GRANTING
\$132,000 IN ROAD FUNDS TO THE CITY OF
SPRINGFIELD AND \$50,000 IN ROAD FUNDS TO THE
CITY OF EUGENE.

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield and the City of Eugene are in need of additional road funds for road projects, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners would like to assist the City of Springfield and the City of Eugene in these efforts;

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield is contemplating expenditures on the specific improvements identified as Main Street Sidewalk Construction and the West "G" Street, Kelly to Water;

WHEREAS, the City of Eugene is contemplating expenditures on the projects identified as Whiteaker Traffic Control (4th Avenue/Monroe to Blair); Whiteaker Traffic Control (Blair and Van Buren); Whiteaker Traffic Control (5th Avenue/Polk to Blair); and Sidewalk improvements near Whiteaker School;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED, that:

THE ORDER BE APPROVED THAT THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR MAY EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD WHICH GRANTS \$132,000 OF ROAD FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT THOSE ROAD FUND PROJECTS LISTED ABOVE; THAT THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR MAY EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF EUGENE WHICH GRANTS \$50,000 OF ROAD FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT ROAD FUND PROJECTS LISTED ABOVE; AND THAT THE RESPECTIVE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS CONTAIN CLAUSES THAT REQUIRE EACH CITY TO EXPEND COUNTY ROAD FUNDS FOR THE EXCLUSIVE PURPOSES ALLOWED BY OREGON LAW FOR ROAD FUNDS.
