WHEREAS, at a duly publicized time and place on February, 22, 1991, Craig Satein of the Housing Authority and Community Services Agency of Lane County, Oregon, opened bids on the following project:

Furnishing all labor and most materials to perform the Weatherization of Homes, Phase 91W-1,2, and 3, in strict accordance with the project specifications prepared by the Agency.

WHEREAS, the apparent lowest responsible bidders for the work were Southtowne Glass phase 91W-1 of \$2,159 per home, Marshall's Oil and Insulation phase 91W-2 of \$2,222 per home, and Lane County Glass phase 91W-3 of \$2,399 per home; the Executive Director having so recommended; IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED, that Southtowne Glass be awarded phase 91W-1 for \$100,000, Marshall's Oil and Insulation be awarded 91W-2 for \$100,000, and Lane County Glass be awarded phase 91W-3 for \$100,000, for the Weatherization of Homes Projects, and that the agreements be executed in accordance with the bid documents. The contractors shall present valid performance and payment bonds for the full contract amounts, and shall satisfactorily complete all work within the specified contract time.
