ORDINANCE NO. 16A-91) IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING ORDINANCE
) NO. 14-90D TO EXTEND THE SUNSET DATE OF
) November 30, 1991 TO JUNE 1, 1993 AND
) DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The Board of County Commissioners of Lane County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 14-90D is amended to extend the sunset date by deleting references to November 30, 1991 and inserting June 1, 1993 in the title and sunset clause. As amended, the sunset clause of Ordinance 14-90D reads as follows:

"Unless further amended by the Board, this ordinance shall expire and be of no legal effect on June 1, 1993."

The purpose of this amendment is to assure that Ordinance 14-90D continues in effect through May 31, 1993.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance, being enacted by the Board in the exercise of its police power for the purpose of meeting such emergency and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
