ORDER 94-1-26- 1

In the Matter of Approving an Agreement with the City of Eugene, the City of Springfield, and the Lane County Housing Authority and Community Services Agency (HACSA) to Continue the Intergovernmental Housing Policy Board

WHEREAS, Lane County recognizes the need to address the community issues of homelessness and increasing the supply of permanent, affordable housing for lower income households;;

WHEREAS, ORS 190.010 provides that units of local government may enter into agreements for the performance of any or all functions and activities that a party to the agreement, its officers or agents, have authority to perform;

WHEREAS, over the past three years, an intergovernmental approach has been used to enhance cooperation between jurisdictions and maximize the use of resources available by local governments to affect the housing related problems of lower income persons,

WHEREAS, the intergovernmental agreement instituting this cooperative approach expired in October 1993; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Eugene and Springfield have already indicated their willingness to continue this intergovernmental approach;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED, THAT THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR IS AUTHORIZED TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF EUGENE, THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, AND THE HOUSING AUTHORITY AND COMMUNITY SERVICES AGENCY (HACSA) TO CONTINUE THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL HOUSING POLICY BOARD.
