ORDER 94-11-22-18 ) In the Matter of Selecting 1995 CDBG Projects

Whereas, Lane County is an eligible applicant for funding of Community Development Block Grant projects from the state of Oregon Community Development Program, and

Whereas, Lane County has followed a citizen participation plan aimed at informing and involving people and agencies serving low income citizens of Lane County, and

Whereas, the Lane County Board of Commissioners has held the required public hearing to determine needs for funding of projects that serve lower income and eligible populations, and


Whereas, the Board of Commissioners has reviewed the options for projects presented by the public and identified by County staff, NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY:

(1) ORDERED that the community development projects, listed in priority order, for 1995 Oregon Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) consideration shall be:

- (a) Mapleton Water District Improvements Design and Construction
- (b) Lake Creek/Blachly Fire Station/Community Center Project
- (c) Marcola Water District Facility Improvements
- (d) Heceta Water District Improvements
- (e) Facilities to Serve Youth In Rural Areas
- (f) Projects that Support Rural Family-Wage Job Opportunities
- (g) Coordination of Rural Housing Rehabilitation, Home Repair and related services.

(2) FURTHER ORDERED that the highest ranked projects, above, shall be listed in the second public hearing notice as the project(s) Lane County is preparing to submit for funding in the 1995 CDBG application process.
