WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has accepted revenues pursuant to the 1993-95 Intergovernmental Agreement #20-001 with the State Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Services Division; and

WHEREAS, the above mentioned agreement provides for Lane County to provide community mental health services to children and adolescents; and

WHEREAS, a five-year grant from the federal government in the amount of \$13,977,468 has been awarded Lane County for the purpose of expanding and improving its community mental health services for children and adolescents mentioned above; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services must use a portion of those revenues in fiscal year 1994-95 through its administrative agency, Lane County; and

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners as the governing board of Lane County may, in accordance with Oregon Revised Statute 294.326(2), appropriate by resolution unanticipated revenues and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, Lane County Mental Health is in need of three staff positions in order to begin the implementation of the program for which the above mentioned grant was intended; it is hereby

ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners accept a five-year \$13,977,468 grant from the federal government for the purpose of expanding and improving its community mental health services for children and adolescents; and it is

ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners increase the fiscal year 1994-95 budget for the Department of Health and Human Services by the increase in appropriations in Fund 24 of \$689,010 in revenues and expenditures; and it is

ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners establish a 1.0 FTE Children and Adolescent Behavioral Health Program Manager position, a .5 FTE PC Support Technician position, and a .5 FTE Accounting Clerk I position in the Department of Health and Human Services; and it is further

ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute documents required for the implementation of the grant.
