WHEREAS, on September 14, 1993, the Board of County Commissioner approved the amended 1993-95 Community Corrections Plan for Lane County; and

WHEREAS, the amended Community Corrections Plan includes funding for a County intensive supervision unit for sex offenders; and

WHEREAS, the development and operation of such an intensive supervision unit would best be accomplished by the joint effort of the Oregon Department of Corrections and Lane County under the authority of Lane County Justice Services; it is hereby

ORDERED that Lane County enter into an intergovernmental agreement with Oregon Department of Corrections for the period of April 1, 1994, to June 30, 1995; and it is further

ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners delegate authority to the County Administrator to approve and execute an intergovernmental agreement with Oregon Department of Corrections.
