WHEREAS, the Child Advocacy Center of the Lane County District Attorney's Office was established to offer assistance to child abuse victims; and

WHEREAS; in order to effectively serve child victims of abuse, adequate funding is actively being sought to support critically important start-up costs; and,

WHEREAS; the Child Advocacy Center has been and is conducting fundraising efforts to support these expenses; and

WHEREAS; in order to effectively serve child victims of abuse, adequate supplies, equipment and furnishings are essential; and

WHEREAS; the Board of County Commissioners as the governing body of Lane County may, in accordance with ORS 294.326(2), appropriate unanticipated revenues and expenditures by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that within the General Fund (24) \$20,000 in additional revenue and expenses is appropriated to the District Attorney's Office (11) to support start-up costs for the Child Advocacy Center.
