ORDER NO. 94-6-7-9

WHEREAS, at the duly authorized time and place on March 15, 1994, a duly authorized representative of Regional Information System, under authority of Lane Manual Chapter 21, opened Proposals for the following:

CP93/94-10 Purchase of an Integrated Help Desk, Asset Management and Change Control software system.

WHEREAS all proposals were evaluated by Regional Information System and the City of Eugene ISD, for conformance to Request for Proposal specifications;

THEREFORE, IT IS NOW HEREBY ORDERED, that the selected vendor, DKSystems Incorporated, be awarded a purchase contract at a total cost of \$32,149.55, and two additional personal services contracts, each of which will not exceed \$15,000, for modifications to software; that funding will be provided entirely by RIS partner City of Eugene and appropriations available in Fund 52 (Information Systems); that a software license agreement and two personal services contracts be executed in accordance with the Request For Proposal Requirements; and that the Lane County Administrator is authorized to sign the agreements and contracts.



discussion within 14-days of the date of the notice. Applicants who did not meet the selection criteria may not reapply for six months.

- (c) When a vacancy occurs, applicants at the top of the waiting list will be notified of the upcoming vacancy. Applicants will have five days to accept or refuse a unit. Applicants may refuse three offers without good cause. After three refusals the applicant will be placed at the bottom of the waiting list.
 - (d) Due to the expected length of the scattered site incentive transfer waiting list the initial criteria will again be reviewed and a unit inspection completed prior to assigning the new unit.
8. In the event a unit becomes available at a Scattered Site and there are no qualified applicants waiting to transfer to a Scattered Site, Agency may, at its discretion, select an eligible applicant from the Public Housing Waiting List.
