ORDINANCE 12-94

-) IN THE MATTER OF AMENDING CHAPTER
-) 2 OF LANE CODE TO CREATE A LOCAL
-) CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD AND
-) DECLARING AN EMERGENCY (LC 2.060)

WHEREAS, ORS 279.055 allows counties to create the governing body as a local contract review board with the power and duty to adopt rules governing public contracts for itself and other local agencies which do not create their own contract review board, and

WHEREAS, Lane County has previously contracted with the State Department of Administrative Services to perform contract review board functions, and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Administrative Services has recently adopted amended rules which become cumbersome and expensive in their application to Lane County, now, therefore,

The Board of County Commissioners of Lane County ordains as follows:

Chapter 2 of Lane Code is hereby amended by substituting the following page:

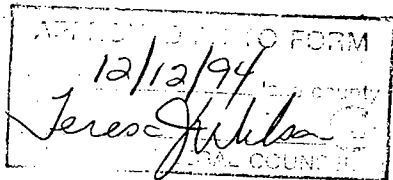

2.030 Failure to Comply. Sections 2.020 and 2.025 are directory rather than mandatory and failure to comply with them shall not invalidate an ordinance.

2.040 Contracts Pursuant to Bid. No agreement or contract shall be entered into by Lane County with any party pursuant to bids under ORS Chapter 279 unless bid review procedures as adopted by order of the Lane County Board of Commissioners shall have been completed prior to the award of the bid. The procedures shall include legal review of the bid documents by the Lane County Office of Legal Counsel and review of the availability of budgeted funds by the department seeking the materials or services let for bid.

2.050 Long-Term Purchase Agreements for Personal Property. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the County Charter and ORS 203.035, the Board may, by order, authorize the County to enter into long-term installment purchase agreements, lease purchase agreements, or other agreements to acquire personal property, if all payments due under such agreements are subject to the appropriation of funds. Any such agreements previously approved by the Board are hereby ratified and confirmed.

2.060 Contract Review Board (CRB).
(1) Pursuant to ORS 279.055, the Lane County Board of Commissioners creates and designates itself as a local Contract Review Board (CRB), with all the powers and authorities provided in ORS Chapter 279.
(2) The CRB shall adopt rules governing public contracts by Board Order.
(3) The CRB may impose fees by Board Order for local public agencies for which it serves as their contract review board.

2.070 Subdivision Plat Approval.
Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the County Charter and ORS 92.100, the Chair of the Board, or the vice-chair when the chair is absent, is authorized to approve all subdivision plats upon presentation for approval by the County Surveyor or his or her designee.
