INTERIM AGREEMENT FOR EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

We, the duly authorized representatives of _____ (hereinafter called the Sponsor), hereby grant to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, (hereinafter called the Government), its contractors and assigns, a permit for right-of-way on property under its control at _____ and in connection with the performance of emergency by Government, further agree to:

a. Provide without cost to the Government, all lands, easements, and rights-of-way for sites of structures, borrow and disposal areas, and for access: also for all other private property as needed by the Government in connection with the authorized work.

b. Hold and save the Government free from damages attributable to the completion of the approved work except where such damages are due to the fault or negligence of the Government or its contractors.

c. Maintain and operate, in a manner satisfactory to the Chief of Engineers, all interrelated features of all protective works under the control of the Sponsor; except the construction of temporary protective works which shall be removed by the Sponsor, or upgraded by the Sponsor at their expense, at no cost to the Corps under PL 84-99, to meet all Government criteria for permanent projects, including permit compliance, environmental, and other regulatory, legal and contractual sponsorship requirements.

This agreement shall start on _____, and end upon completion of the approved work, or within 90 days, except when the approved work is upgraded by the Sponsor, in which case ingress and egress for Government inspection of operation and maintenance shall extend to the life of the approved project.
