WHEREAS, at a duly publicized time and place on March 13, 1995, Craig Satein of the Housing Authority and Community Services Agency of Lane County, Oregon, opened bids on the following projects:

Furnishing all labor and most materials to perform the Weatherization of Homes, Phases 95W-1, 95W-2 and 95W-3, in strict accordance with the project specifications prepared by the Agency.

WHEREAS, the apparent lowest responsible bidders for the work were Emerald Valley Weatherization at \$2,088 per house; Southtowne Glass at \$2,094 per house; and Lane County Glass at \$2,165 per house; the Executive Director having so recommended;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Emerald Valley Weatherization be awarded a \$100,000 requirements contract for the Weatherization of Homes Project Phase 95W-1, that Southtowne Glass be awarded a \$100,000 requirements contract for the Weatherization of Homes Project Phase 95W-2, and that Lane County Glass be awarded a \$200,000 requirements contract for the Weatherization of Homes Project Phase 95W-3, and that the agreements be executed by the Executive Director in accordance with the bid documents. The contractors shall present a valid performance and payment bond for the full contract amount, and shall satisfactorily complete all work within the specified contract time.
