WHEREAS, on February 3, 1995, Oliver Snowden, County Engineer, Lane County Department of Public Works, under authority of Lane Manual Chapter 21, received requests for proposals for the purchase of global positioning system (GPS) survey equipment; and


WHEREAS, two (2) proposals were reviewed and submitting vendors demonstrated equipment capabilities for compliance to the specifications; and

WHEREAS, it was determined by a selection committee that NESSCO Supply, Inc. has been chosen based on qualifications, support, and equipment and software capabilities to furnish Leica global positioning system survey equipment, and the Director of the Department of Public Works recommends that the bid be accepted: NOW THEREFORE BE IT

ORDERED, that the agreed quote received from NESSCO Supply, Inc., in the amount of \$45,059.24 be accepted as recommended; and it is further

ORDERED that the contract be executed in accordance with this Order and the contract specifications and the County Administrator be authorized to sign the contract.
