Whereas, the Applegate Trail was one of the original emigrant routes to Lane County and is recognized as a historic land mark by state and federal agencies, and

Whereas, the Lane County Economic Development Standing Committee has recommended consideration of the Applegate Trail Committee proposal to implement the Applegate Trail Interpretive project and by this action leverage state and local funds for the project, and


Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners considers it in the best interests of Lane County to provide funding from operational contingency funds to meet deadlines imposed by the state legislation and agencies, and consistent with the goals in the Lane County Economic Development Strategic Plan, NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY


