WHEREAS, Lane County is a participating county in the Community Corrections Act (CCA); and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 1993, the Board of County Commissioners approved the amended 1993-95 Community Corrections Plan for Lane County; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon state legislature has yet to adopt the Governor's Corrections Proposal for the 1995-97 biennium; and

WHEREAS, current Community Corrections Act subcontracts, monitored by Lane County Justice Services, expire on June 30, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the Community Corrections Advisory Committee (CCAC) now recommends that current CCA contracts be extended for a three month interim period (July 1, 1995 to September 30, 1995) to avoid an interruption of services, incorporating 20% reductions, all of which is outlined in Attachment A; it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Board of County Commissioners approve three month extensions for CCA contracts, incorporating 20% reductions; and it is further

ORDERED, that the County Administrator be granted the authority to sign subcontracts over \$25,000.
