ORDERED that the following new classification and salary range be established as follows:

Waste Management Fee Collection Program Manager - Range 32 - \$32,885 - \$44,075

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the existing classification and salary range of Senior Waste Management Fee Collector be amended as follows:

Senior Waste Management Fee Collector - Range 21 - \$25,043 - \$33,550
